

## Cost of Services

Our low cost spay/neuter service includes intra-operative pain medication. It is recommended that your pet be vaccinated at least 14 days prior to surgery. If this is not possible, vaccines may be given at the time of surgery. All animals age 3 months or older must be vaccinated for rabies, either at your vet or at time of surgery.

### PET OVER-POPULATION

Thanks to the support of the Ryan Newman Foundation, SNIP Regional Spay/Neuter Clinic is pleased to offer a low-cost sterilization program to the pet owners of the foothills and piedmont regions of NC. Call 704-799-SNIP (Mooresville clinic) for more information on services we can provide for you and your pet.

#### Here's why it is important to spay or neuter your pet:

- Reducing the breeding population of dogs and cats is the only way to eliminate the need to euthanize thousands of adoptable animals.
- Spaying and neutering your pet provides many behavioral benefits that include reducing aggressiveness and wanderings.
- Many health benefits can be attributed to spaying and neutering including decreasing the risk of many types of cancers.
- Early spay/neuter surgeries (as young as 8 weeks) are easier on a pet than waiting until it is older, overweight or has other health issues. Young animals must be 8 weeks old and weigh at least 3 lbs.
- A female in heat or pregnant may be safely spayed. Nursing mothers need to stop nursing at least 2 weeks prior to surgery and cannot be lactating.

## How It Works

SNIP Regional Spay/Neuter Clinic is pleased to partner with All Wags Doggie Day Care & Boarding to offer the people and pets of south Charlotte a low-cost, high-quality spay/neuter program. You may register your pet for surgery at All Wags located at 670 Griffith Road, Charlotte 28217. Call them at 704-527-WAGS (9247) for more information. Your pet must have proof of a current rabies vaccination or one will be required at the time of surgery. Other vaccines are also available to your pet in addition to sterilization services. We accept cash, credit or debit cards. SNIP will transport your pet safely from the All Wags location for surgery. Your pet will be spayed or neutered, monitored during surgery and recovery, examined and returned to All Wags the next morning. A complete set of post-operative instructions will be given to you when you pick up your pet.

Directions to All Wags Doggie Daycare & Boarding: I-77 South to Exit 5 (Tyvola). Take a left off the ramp and turn right onto West Park Drive. Go to Griffith Road and turn left. All Wags Doggie Daycare & Boarding is a white building on your right, #670 Griffith Road.

## What You Need To Know

- Registration for SNIP Regional Spay/Neuter Clinic must be done in person or by phone at All Wags Doggie Daycare Mon.-Fri. from 12-6 p.m.; Sat. 2-6 p.m. Call 704-527-9247 (WAGS).
- You must bring your pets' rabies certificate or your pet will be required to receive another rabies vaccine at the time of surgery for an \$8 fee.
- Transport from All Wags to SNIP will take place once a month.
- If your pet is over 3 months of age and has never had a rabies vaccine, your pet will be required to have the vaccine given at the time of surgery.
- You must pay for the surgery, vaccines and services in advance of your surgery appointment with cash, credit or debit card.

On the night before your appointment, withhold food and water from your pet **after 10 pm** if it is over 4 months of age. Kittens and puppies less than 4 months of age may have food and water until midnight. On the day of your pet's surgery, come to All Wags Doggie Daycare between 7:30-8:00 a.m.. Be sure your dog is on a leash and give your dog a quick walk. Your cat must be in cat carrier. Your pet will be returned to the All Wags parking lot the next morning at 8:00 a.m.

**Post-op instructions will be given to you at time of pick up and any medications prescribed or additional surgical charges will need to be paid at this time. Any extra surgery charges due to complications will be explained to you fully by our veterinary support staff.**
